This one-day event in the streets of historic downtown Sopchoppy, Florida, offers a great opportunity for folks to purchase your goods for Christmas gifts. Last year we had 45 vendors and a great crowd. And Santa will be in the house to get them in the mood!

**You can set up on Friday afternoon from 3:30 to 5:30 P.M. or on Saturday morning from 7:30 until 9:00 A.M. We will show you to your space when you arrive.**

The hours for booths are from 9:00 am until 4:00 pm. The fee for a 12' by 12' space is \$15 for arts and crafts and \$30 for food and concession vendors or anyone needing electric or water hookup. Educational and Public Service booths not raising money are free. Fees are used to pay expenses for the event such as newspaper ads and signs. If you sign up early it will help us plan and you will be in line for a better space.

We control food and concession vendors to avoid having too many selling the same products so if you are a food or concession vendor return your application as early as possible. In addition, you should be aware that state inspectors carefully checked all food booths for ***proper licenses and health and safety requirements*** at our festivals.
