

History

The Sopchoppy Train Depot was built along the railroad tracks laid down by the Carrabelle, Tallahassee & Georgia Railroad Company in 1893. The city of Sopchoppy grew up around the tracks and was the largest incorporated town in Wakulla County by 1910.

In the 1890s, the Georgia Pine Railway started toward Tallahassee from Bainbridge. It became the Georgia, Florida, and Alabama line in 1901(G F & A), and was referred to as "the Sumatra Leaf Line, "and sometimes the "Gopher, Frog, and Alligator." This line passed through Sopchoppy and headed on to Carrabelle The Seaboard Air Line operated trains through Sopchoppy after 1930, until the last train departed in 1946.

The City of Sopchoppy renovated the depot in 2009/2010, and plans to open the restored train depot to the public as a historical landmark.


