Special Called Meeting – Inter-local Agreement with Wakulla County

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Mayor Lara Edwards with salute to the flag. In attendance: Edwards, Roddenberry, Lewis

Somer Pell, Director, Wakulla County Planning and Zoning, was present to address the Council. An engineer with Dollar General has contacted the County and needs clarification as to whether the company should follow Wakulla County or City codes. Generally, where the City does not address an area of concern and does not already have an inter-local agreement in place pertaining to the issue, then the County codes are followed.

A decision was made to draft an open ended Inter-local Agreement between the City of Sopchoppy and Wakulla County as it pertains to overseeing planning and zoning requirements and conditions relating to Dollar General and potential future commercial growth within the City limits (at the request of the City).

The Inter-local Agreement will be presented at the December 11, City Council meeting.

With no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Roddenberry, second by Lewis, 3/0. The meeting adjourned at 6:55.
