

June 10, 2024

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Councilmember Lara Edwards with prayer and salute to the flag. In attendance: McClendon, Harden, and Edwards.

A motion to approve the May 20, 2024, minutes was made by Edwards, second by McClendon, 3/0.

The Council held the **2nd public hearing and adoption for Ordinance 2024-03** - An Ordinance Of The City Of Sopchoppy, Florida, Amending The City Of Sopchoppy Land Development Code Article IV-Zoning District Regulations; Providing For Severability; Repealing All Ordinances In Conflict; And Providing An Effective Date. The ordinance was read by title only by City Clerk Ashley Schilling. Attorney Dan Cox explained this is a corrective ordinance to include newly adopted setbacks for all residential zonings. A **motion** to adopt Ordinance 2024-03 as presented was made by Edwards, second by Harden, 3/0.

Clerk Schilling requested the July meeting be changed from the 8th to the 15th. The Council approved the change.

The financials and adjustments were approved by signature of the Council.

Public Works Director Seth Green reported the City is moving forward with the installation of the 12" pipe on MLK.

Councilmember Edwards requested someone weed-eat the riverbank at the City Park to deter snakes.

Clerk Schilling reminded everyone there are three seats on the Council up for re-election in November. The packets are ready and must be returned before the qualifying period begins on July 15.

Attorney Cox will be holding an ethics seminar and will let the Council know, should anyone be interested in attending.

With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:46 p.m. Motion by Edwards, second by Harden.
